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## Whitestone awarded NIEHS/EPA and DOE contracts

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The National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences and The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency have jointly awarded a \$27 million dollar contract to The Whitestone Group, Inc. Whitestone, a physical security company based in Columbus, OH, provides physical security for federal facilities in the United States and its Territories. Whitestone won the five year contract in a competitive bid process and will service the security needs of the two agencies at Research Triangle Park in North Carolina.



In another competitive bid process, Whitestone was awarded a \$3.5 million, five year contract by the Department of Energy. Whitestone will provide security services for the agency's National Nuclear Security Administration facilities in Albuquerque, NM. "We already have several security contracts with these agencies and this was just a natural progression for us," said John D. Clark, Whitestone's President and CEO. According to Pam Gentile, Whitestone COO, several other contracts were awarded to the company within the last year.
